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PART 2- HOW ON EARTH...

1- WORLD MAP

Today, there are Christians all over the world. In which country can people see the Bibleworld exhibition? Look at the pictures to get the answer.

2- MAP OF EUROPE

After Jesus died, rose again and went back to heaven, one of his followers, Paul, wanted to tell everybody what had happened. To do this he took a long journey, starting at Antioch in Syria (see the small map). What continent did he enter when he crossed to Philippi in Macedonia?

3-GLOBE

Switch the globe light on to see the country names. Find Israel (where Jerusalem is). Now find Scotland. Look at the little dial with times at the top of the globe. When it is 12 o'clock in Jerusalem, it is 9 o'clock in Scotland. Is the time earlier or later in Jerusalem? Fill in answer 2 in the word quiz.

4- MAP COMPUTER PROGRAM

The Christian Gospel traveled a long way to get to Scotland. To find how far the message went, look at the map on the screen.

Click on MEASURE on the right side of the screen.

Click on JORDAN (near Jerusalem) and drag the mouse on to SCOTLAND and click again.

This should draw a line and show the distance from Jordan to Scotland. Fill in answer 5 in the word quiz. Just write the number to the nearest thousand kilometers (eg write 9536 as 'nine').

5- COLUMBA'S JOURNEY

Saint Columba was one of the first people to bring the Christian message to Scotland. He came from Ireland and landed on Iona. Find Iona on the map. What bigger island is Iona near? Fill in answer 5 in the word quiz.

6- REPEAT OF COLUMBA'S JOURNEY IN 1997

1400 years after the death of Columba, some people from Ireland made the same journey again in a currach. A currach (or currach) is a type of Irish

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7 LIFE ON IONA
